Did you know that the HSE state that where a training provider uses training material other than the Voluntary Aid Societies' First Aid Manual, the material must be supported by a responsible body of governance?

Legal advice from the Resuscitation Council UK also explains that in order to withstand the scrutiny of law, first aid advice should be supported by a responsible body of medical opinion.
